Not only orphans but also elephants who are seriously injured or those who get aloof from their group are given proper shelter & care at the orphanage.

### **Peradeniya Royal Botanical Gardens**

### **Bahirawakanda Temple**

The temple on the hill of Bahirawakanda, called the Sri Maha Bodhi Viharaya, is most well-known to tourists for its giant Buddha statue, which can be seen from almost any point in the city of Kandy. Built in 1972, the statue shows Lord Buddha seated in the Nirvana pose, which is the position associated with his first Enlightenment. Reaching a height of more than 25 metres, it is one of the tallest statues of Buddha in Sri Lanka. **The ticket must be purchased in USD at the time of entry**

### **Kandy Lake**

The Kandy Lake is a Great place to People to watch in the shade of the ancient trees. Go for a walk with your travel buddy. One of the unique aspects of Kandy as its laidback streets. Full of colorful kaleidoscope of colonial building house.
