DAY 01 [COLOMBO - NUWARAELIYA - APPROX 05 HRS DRIVE]

After breakfast, around 08.00 AM, you will be welcomed by Tangerine Tours representative and be escorted to your vehicle to start your journey by proceeding to Nuwara Eliya.

Drive through Nuwara Eliya city, which is a picturesque town, Known for its cool climate, lush greenery and colonial charm.

Take a Boat ride on **Gregory Lake** which is a man-made lake that offers visitors to enjoy boat rides, pony rides and leisurely walks around the lake while taking in the scenic views of the surrounding hills and forests.

DINNER & OVER NIGHT STAY AT NUWARA ELIYA

DAY 02 [NUWARAELIYA - BEACH - APPROX 05 HRS DRIVE]

After Breakfast explore the enchanting **Hakgala Botanical Garden**, renowned for its breathtaking beauty and diverse plant life with the lush landscapes, vibrant flowers and tranquil ponds, that is linked to the mythical Ashoka Vatika, located in the vicinity of Hakgala, which is believed to be the garden where Sita, the wife of Lord Rama, was held captive by the demon king Ravana from the epic Ramayana.

Thereafter proceed to Beach via **Kitulgala**, where adventure awaits. Embark on an exhilarating journey down the Kelani River, covering 5 major rapids and 4 minor ones with Safety briefing and modern equipment provided, promising an adrenaline-fueled experience amidst breathtaking scenery. For those seeking a more leisurely experience, revel in the stunning vistas of Kitulgala without getting wet, offering a serene alternative to the rafting adventure.

DINNER & OVER NIGHT STAY AT BERUWALA

DAY 03 [BERUWALA - AIRPORT - APPROX 02 ½ HRS DRIVE]

After breakfast **visit Turtle Hatchery**, you will get to see up to five endangered species of turtles hatching and crisscrossing each other. It is a meaningful way to contribute to wildlife conservation efforts and help protect the magnificent creatures for years to come.

Madu River Boat Safari - The Madu River is a scenic waterway that offers boat safaris through mangrove forests, small islands and traditional fishing villages, to discover a diverse array of wildlife, including birds, reptiles and aquatic creatures, while learning about the local ecosystem and way of life.

Thereafter proceed to Airport to connect the departure flight.
