DAY 01**AIRPORT – DAMBULLA / SIGIRIYA - APPROX 04 HRS DRIVE**

“**Ayubowan**”– Welcome to Sri Lanka. Upon your arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport, a warm reception awaits you from our dedicated representative at Tangerine Tours and be escorted to your vehicle to start your journey in Sri Lanka by proceeding to **Dambulla / Sigiriya / Habarana**

Enroute visit **Dambulla Cave Temple**, A sacred pilgrimage site for 22 centuries, also known as the Golden Temple of Dambulla, this cave monastery, with its five sanctuaries, is the largest, best-preserved cave-temple complex in Sri Lanka.

DINNER AND OVER NIGHT STAY AT DAMBULLA / SIGIRIYA / HABARANA**DAY 02****DAMBULLA - KANDY - APPROX 02 ½ HRS****DRIVE**

After Breakfast visit **Sigiriya Rock Fortress**, the ancient rock citadel is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Sri Lanka's most iconic landmarks with impressive frescoes, the Lion Gate, gardens, moats, a mirror wall, and a royal palace on top.

Thereafter proceed to Kandy, along your way you could stop at a **Spice Garden** in Matale where scents of cinnamons, pepper, cardamom, nutmeg, and mace overpower the faculties.

Evening explore Kandy City, the hill capital of Sri Lanka which was declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1988, is a beautiful city surrounded by mountains.

The Temple of the Tooth Relic is the jewel in the heart of the old city, captivating and majestic which is a major pilgrimage site for Buddhists and a symbol of Sri Lankan cultural and religious heritage.

Kandy Lake is an artificial reservoir that enhances the city's natural beauty, surrounded by lush greenery which offers a tranquil escape where you can enjoy leisurely strolls along its scenic promenade.

Conclude the day with **Kandyan Cultural Dance Performance** which showcases the vibrant music and dance traditions of the region, including fire dances, drumming, and acrobatic performances.

DINNER & OVER NIGHT STAY AT KANDY**DAY 03****KANDY - NUWARA ELIYA - ELLA - APPROX 05 HRS****DRIVE**

After breakfast proceed to Ella via Nuwara Eliya, also known as "Little England," On your way along you will pay the visit to Ramboda waterfalls.

Towering gracefully over the surrounding scenery, **Ramboda Water Falls** ranks as the eleventh tallest waterfall in Sri Lanka and also steeped in myth and legend which is the very spot where God Hanuman famously leaped to Sri Lanka and paused during his quest to find Goddess Sita, struck the ground with his staff in his thirst, causing water to gush forth and form the magnificent Ramboda Falls.

Further on, explore **Tea Factory** to experience the sights, smells, and tastes of tea production. Enjoy a cup of unique Ceylon tea, gaining insights into its distinctive flavors.

Thereafter drive through Nuwara Eliya, which is a picturesque town, Known for its cool climate, lush greenery, and colonial charm.

Visit **The spectacular Seetha Amman Kovil** which is dedicated to Goddess Seetha. According to Hindu mythology, this is believed to be the place where Goddess Seetha was held captive by King Ravana. On the rock face across the stream by the side of the temple are circular depressions that are regarded to be the footprints of Hanuman.

Explore the enchanting **Hakgala Botanical Garden**, renowned for its breathtaking beauty and diverse plant life with the lush landscapes, vibrant flowers and tranquil ponds, that is linked to the mythical Ashoka Vatika, located in the vicinity of Hakgala, which is believed to be the garden where Sita, the wife of Lord Rama, was held captive by the demon king Ravana from the epic Ramayana.

Take a Boat ride on Gregory Lake which is a man-made lake that offers visitors to enjoy boat rides, pony rides and leisurely walks around the lake while taking in the scenic views of the surrounding hills and forests.

There after proceeding to **Ella**.

After enjoying breakfast, move forward to explore **Ella city**.

Please note that while we've listed the attractions in Ella below, it's important to keep in mind that visiting all of them within the allotted time is not possible. To tailor your experience to your preferences, we offer flexibility in selecting the destinations you're most interested in.

Experience a thrilling ride on **Flying Ravana Zip Line** which is of two-wire zip-line stretching over half a kilometer, reaching speed of 80kmph that offers a bird's-eye view of the beautiful hills of the island. Fly over iconic tea estates and lush greenery overlooking the famous Ella Gap.

Little Adam's Peak, a relatively easy hike, leads to the summit of this peak, offering panoramic views of Ella's lush green landscape.

Relax at **Ravana Pool club** featuring a massive restaurant, a large main pool, private VIP pools, a heated jacuzzi, a party platform, a pool bar and deck, with many day beds, sun beds and lounge seating. Enjoy the majestic views of Ella Rock. **(Charges Applicable)**

Explore the secluded beauty of **Ella Nil Diya Pokuna** also known as Ravana's Cave Pool created by King Ravana himself which had been enjoyed by Ravana's consort, Sita, during her time in captivity adding a touch of myth and mystique. Immerse in the tranquil waters of this pristine pool, surrounded by lush greenery and rugged landscapes.

Nine Arch Bridge Marvel at this iconic railway bridge surrounded by picturesque scenery. A short 30-minute walk through the jungle leads to the hidden architectural gem nestled among lush green tea fields. Visitors can watch trains pass over the bridge against a backdrop of rolling hills and walk on it.

DAY 05 **ELLA - YALA - APPROX 02 ½ HRS DRIVE**

After having breakfast, check out and proceed to **Yala**, Enroute visit Ravana Waterfalls.

Delve into the mythical tales and be enchanted by the majestic **Ravana Water Falls**, a breathtaking waterfall steeped in legend and lore, where the King Ravana stopped to quench his thirst during his pursuit of Sita, creating this magnificent waterfall with a strike of his mighty sword.

Evening Safari at Yala National Park (03.00 – 06.00 PM)

Known for its diverse wildlife, Yala is one of the best places in Sri Lanka to spot leopards, elephants, sloth bears and a variety of bird species. Safari tours offer an opportunity to explore the park's varied ecosystems.

DAY 06 **YALA - BENTOTA / KALUTARA – APPROX 05 ½ HRS DRIVE**

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Bentota/Kalutara, en route visit **Tangalle Hummanaya Blowhole**, Coconut Tree Hills Mirissa, Thaple Beach & Stilt Fishing.

Prepare to be mesmerized by the natural spectacle of the Tangalle **Hummanaya Blowhole**, second largest blow holes in the world, an awe-inspiring phenomenon where seawater shoots high into the air through a hole in the coastal rocks.

Hiriketiya Beach epitomizes paradise on Sri Lanka's renowned south coast. It attracts surfers of all levels with its diverse waves, ranging from 1 to 3 meters high. Whether beginner or experienced, there's something for everyone due to varying water depths.

Thalpe Beach is one of the most popular beaches on Sri Lanka's south coast with unique rectangular rock pools carved into the long-dead coral reef at the shoreline.

Coconut Tree Hills A must-visit in Mirissa, offering stunning views of the Indian Ocean from a high cliff on a private coconut estate.

Stilt Fishing is traditional and ancient fishing practice along the south coast of Sri Lanka, allowing you to experience the art of stilt fishing with the stilt fishermen.

Galle Dutch Fort is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, featuring well-preserved colonial-era fortress built by the Dutch, where streets lined with historic buildings, Boutique & Antique Shops, Gem Shops, Art Galleries and Cafes

BENTOTA

After having a nourishing Breakfast, move forward to explore Bentota.

Breif Garden is a stunning botanical garden that was once the home of renowned Sri Lankan architect Geoffrey Bawa, which features lush greenery, winding pathways and unique sculptures and artworks, attracting nature lovers and art enthusiasts.

At **Turtle Hatchery**, you will get to see up to five endangered species of turtles hatching and crisscrossing each other. It is a meaningful way to contribute to wildlife conservation efforts and help protect the magnificent creatures for years to come.

Madu River Boat Safari - The Madu River is a scenic waterway that offers boat safaris through mangrove forests, small islands and traditional fishing villages, to discover a diverse array of wildlife, including birds, reptiles and aquatic creatures, while learning about the local ecosystem and way of life

Bentota Water Sports - Quench the thirst for adventure with an array of thrilling water sports activities. Whether it's water skiing, windsurfing or banana rides, there's something for every adrenaline junkie here.
